Please submit each of the following as separate MS Word files to mburchar@unca.edu:

- ◆ a paper (approximately 10 pages or 3000 words)
- ◆ an abstract (150-200 words)
- ◆ a separate cover sheet with name and affiliation

Papers on any philosophical topic are welcome. Papers should be designed for a 20-minute presentation time [approximately 10 standard double-spaced pages]. The paper should not contain the author's name or institutional affiliation.

Abstracts should be attached to the paper, should be one paragraph, double-spaced, no more than 150 words. These abstracts should not contain the author's name or institutional affiliation.

Cover sheets should be on a separate sheet, and should contain the title of the paper, the author's name, and the author's institutional affiliation, address, e-mail address, and phone number.

Submissions must be received by Monday, NOVEMBER 26, 2018
